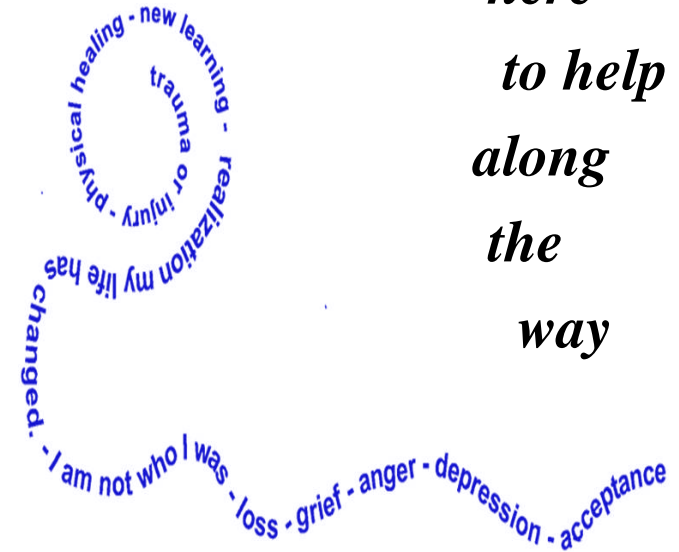
Every year: 10 000 Albertans sustain a brain injury. 1700 to 1800 require ongoing support of one kind or another.

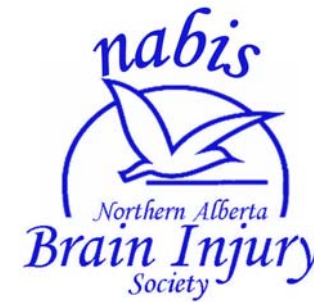
Members receive the quarterly NABIS News, have library borrowing privileges, are welcome to attend the annual general meeting and if elected, serve on the Board of Directors.

The Northern Alberta Brain Injury Society (NABIS) is a non-profit organization, established in 1983, which promotes an optimal lifestyle for northern Albertans affected by brain injury.

NABIS provides a continuum of services to people affected by acquired brain injury including: support, service coordination, information, referral, leisure/recreation and advocacy.

Services we provide

Support - Individual and/or group support to persons affected by brain injury, their family and caregivers (call for locations & times of local groups),
- Assist with goal setting to maximize independence and lifestyle changes, if needed.

Service Coordination

- Coordinate and network services for individuals with brain injury and their families, including the Supports for Community Living Service, which provides up to ten hours/week of assistance to adults affected by brain injury to build or maintain independence,
- Identify community-based supports & services.

Information and Referral

- Provide information and resources to those affected by brain injury, family, caregivers, professionals, and the public,
- Tailor educational sessions to interested groups, the public, and in June, during Brain Injury Awareness Week,
- Lend library resources on brain injury and provide NABIS' quarterly newsletter featuring topics of concern, current activities & viewpoints.

Leisure/Recreation - NABIS supports the provision of accessible and appropriate activities for those affected by brain injury like Edmonton's week-day Networks Activity Centre, or the Getting Out Group's (GoGo's) monthly social outing.

Advocacy

- Need help sorting out living arrangements? Wondering how to apply for AISH or DATS? If appropriate, NABIS will advocate for and with you. Also, we advocate locally, provincially and nationally.

Supported Volunteer Opportunities

- NABIS engages community members, including those affected by brain injury, to assist with NABIS' governance, office and fundraising activities.
